Viscount Viscountess	Your Excellency	Have completed the reign over a principality at least once.		Varies. Coronet with a lot of pearls (>6) or a coronet with one exaggerated point in the front
Order of the Laurel	Master Mistress	Elevated by Royalty for excellence in the Arts and Sciences	personal decoration with a laurel wreath.	Coronet, cloak, etc.
Order of the Pelican	Master Mistress	Elevated by Royalty for excellence in Service.	Cap of maintenance. Decorations with a Pelican, usually in its piety.	Cloak with a pelican on it. Other stuff with a pelican on it.
Order of the Chivalry (Knight or Master)	Sir Master	Elevated by Royalty for Fighting	Plain white belt or baldric. Plain gold chain.	Spurs
Landed Baron Landed Baroness	Your Excellency	Often elected by populace then appointed by the Crown	Any coronet, most commonly with 6 pearls. The right to bear the arms of the Barony.	

Court Baron Court Baroness	Your Excellency	Elevated by the Crown	Any coronet, most commonly with 6 pearls.	Right to a Baronial Coronet on their arms.

Man at Arms	Like a squire but to a person not of the Chivalry	anyone		
Yeoman	Like a squire but for Archery	anyone
